

Arctic Chamomile

Matricaria discoidea

Description

Arctic chamomile grows to 12-inche: high under optimum conditions.
Arctic chamomile has greenishyellow disk flowers with a mild pineapple aroma and taste.

Habitat and Range

Arctic chamomile grows in hard packed soil such as roadside and trails and is considered a weed, but it is a useful plant.

Food Use:

Fill a jar with arctic chamomile flowers, spruce tips, and two pinches of labrador tea leaves. Cover with water. Let sit in bright sunlight for 6-8 hours. Strain and enjoy.
