

Southcentral Foundation Detox

The Southcentral Foundation Detox (withdrawal management) program is open to all Alaska residents ages 18 and older who would like support in completing medical detox. Individuals will comfortably detox in a shared space, under 24-hour medical supervision, engage with employees to determine their next steps in recovery, have access to a behavioral health counselor, and have the option to attend educational sessions.

SCF Detox employees assist in identifying the next steps in a customer's recovery journey by connecting those seeking treatment with providers and programs to meet their needs.

To be added to the SCF Detox contact list, call 907-729-6690. Participants are encouraged to call daily to maintain an active status that may also allow for same day access to the program. Wait times may vary depending on bed availability.

Eligibility

SCF Detox serves all members of the community, ages 18 and older. Medicaid, Medicare, and other insurance is accepted, and a sliding scale fee is available for those who are eligible.

SCF Detox provides:

- · Clothing to wear while in the program.
- · Meals and snacks while in the program.
- Toiletries such as shampoo, conditioner, body wash, lotion, deodorant, toothbrush, toothpaste, and comb.

What to bring:

- Photo ID (required)
- All prescribed medications
- Clothing to wear to and from Detox

- Towels, washcloths, bed linens, blankets, and non-slip socks.
- A selection of books, movies, video games, puzzles, drawing materials, and other art supplies.
- · Undergarments for at least four days
- · Slippers, if desired
