



Alaska Native and American Indian Children are Eligible to Receive Glasses Free of Charge.

Southcentral Foundation knows children need clear eyesight to thrive both in and outside of a classroom and in daily life. For a limited time, Southcentral Foundation is offering families of Alaska Native and American Indian children glasses at no cost.

PROGRAM CRITERIA FOR RECIPIENTS:

- Must be 17 years of age and under.
- Must qualify to receive services at Southcentral Foundation.
- If eligible for Medicaid, Medicaid must be used for the first pair of glasses, however the grant will cover a second pair.
- If covered by private insurance, insurance must be billed first.

FURTHER PROGRAM DETAILS

Funding is provided through a grant from the SEVA Foundation. Limited funds are available and there is a cap for the grant of \$200 per eligible child. These funds will be able to provide up to 500 children glasses!
