1		Is there any possibility of extending the RFP deadline?	To the extent we can without lapse in active subscription/coverage from our existing Microsoft agreement	
2		Agreement vehicle: Exhibit A reflects a mix of cloud subscriptions and on-premises License & Software Assurance products. Can SCF confirm whether the existing agreement is a full Enterprise Agreement (EA), an Enterprise Subscription Agreement, or an EA with a Server and Cloud Enrollment component?	SCF's current agreement is a Microsoft Enterprise Agreement (EA) with a mix of cloud subscription services and on-premises licenses with Software Assurance. It is not an Enterprise Subscription Agreement (EAS), and there is no separate Server and Cloud Enrollment (SCE) component in place.	
3		Renewal program: Given recent Microsoft licensing program changes, can SCF confirm whether this renewal is expected to continue on an Enterprise Agreement, or whether it may transition to CSP (New Commerce Experience) or a Microsoft Customer Agreement at renewal?	SCF is open to evaluating renewal options, including continuation under an Enterprise Agreement or alternative licensing programs (e.g., Microsoft Customer Agreement or CSP), based on overall value, pricing, and alignment with SCF requirements.

Quantities listed in Exhibit A generally reflect the current estimated renewal baseline. The CIS Suite Datacenter Core line with a quantity of 0 is intentional and represents a placeholder for evaluation only; it should be excluded from the current renewal scope.  The Phone Resource Account subscription is included for completeness as required by Microsoft licensing, carries a quantity of 102, and is provided at no cost.	
8		Pricing program: Is SCF purchasing under Microsoft nonprofit, commercial, academic, or another pricing program? The "Existing Customer" designation on the M365 E5 line suggests a current entitlement. Please confirm the applicable price level.	SCF purchases under a Microsoft Enterprise Agreement utilizing nonprofit/charitable pricing eligibility that has been in place for several years. This reflects Microsoft's nonprofit program and pricing considerations and does not indicate academic, commercial, or government cloud-specific licensing.

SCF is open to a short-term bridge or co-termining arrangement if necessary to ensure continuity of licensing and services without lapse.	
10		Engagement duration: Is the scope a point-in-time renewal engagement, or does it include ongoing license management, optimization, and support across the three-year term?	The scope is limited to a point-in-time renewal transaction. Ongoing license management or advisory services are not included in this RFP.	
11		Evaluation and submission: How are the 5 AN/AI Preference points applied (eligibility gate, proportional, or tie-breaker)?	AN/AI Preference is applied as part of the overall evaluation criteria and carries a maximum value of 5 points within the total 100-point scoring model. It is not used as an eligibility requirement or tie-breaker.
